

LIBRARY – The Vedanta

Vedanta is located on the fourth floor of the College building. The Library serves the students and staff members of the college. The main attraction of the college Library is the Open Access system to students and staff members. Students can directly browse through the stacks and pick up the desired books. Internet browsing area is also provided for students. Library collection of books is expended every year by adding new books to the Library. The Library has 40000 books, 44 Periodicals and also subscribes to 16 Newspapers in different languages.

N List Subscription

The College Library has subscribed to infibnet's N-List programme. Under this programme students and Staff Members can access more than 3000 Electronic Journals and more than 90000 Electronic books. Students and teaching faculty also have a remote login facility to access and download articles




LIBRARY – The Vedant




Book Exhibition
