The Career Guidance Cell organised various Workshops, Lectures and seminars, where experts from various fields interacted with students and shared their knowledge as well as experience.

At the beginning of the year Career Guidance Cell had organised a one week Training programme from 15th to 20th July 2019, in the subject of soft skills.
