Details about the nature of assistance to be extended to the community:

PADA SELECTED: Chuna Pada, Sanjay Gandhi National Park.

REASON FOR SELECTING CHUNA PADA:

Pre-Survey findings: On 30th June, we interviewed the officials of SGNP and members of Birsa Munda Adivasi Sangathana (a local NGO) and on the basis of information gathered from them we got to know that CHUNA PADA comprises of absolutely poor people and hence we decided to execute the project in the said pada. The said pada is approximately 4 kms from the National Park Main Gate and it is the last Pada. It is 2 kms prior to Kanheri Caves. We visited Chuna Pada and gathered primary information about the socio-economic status from the tribals.

All padas in National Park have no access to electricity or water. The tribals are not allowed to construct pucca houses; so all the houses are kutcha houses made up of iron sheets. They cover their houses with plastic sheets in the monsoon to prevent water seepage. None of the houses have toilets. There is no mobile network at Chuna Pada.

Men are mostly employed as house - keeping staff by the forest officials and women work as domestic helpers. Children attend school in Abhinav Nagar and have to walk through jungle area (1/2 hr one way) to reach the school. There is constant fear of animal attack and hence most parents are scared to send their children to school.

NATURE OF ASSISTANCE EXTENDED: We carried out the donation camp on Saturday, 3rd July 2021 at 2.00 pm in Chuna Pada, Sanjay Gandhi National Park

With the help of financial assistance received from the Lions Club of Malad –Borivli, we donated FOOD kit- Comprising of Rice (2KG), Wheat Atta (2 KG) and Oil (1 LITRE) to 29 families. The details of the amount spent is mentioned below:

We also decided to donate stationary to 48 children (right from 1st standard till SY degree) of Chuna Pada. The details of the amount spent by us is mentioned below:
