

METHODOLOGY	The entire event was conducted in the auditorium IN OFFLINE MODE.

Third Place (₹1,250): Mr. Shaikh Mohd. Shafiq (TYBAF)

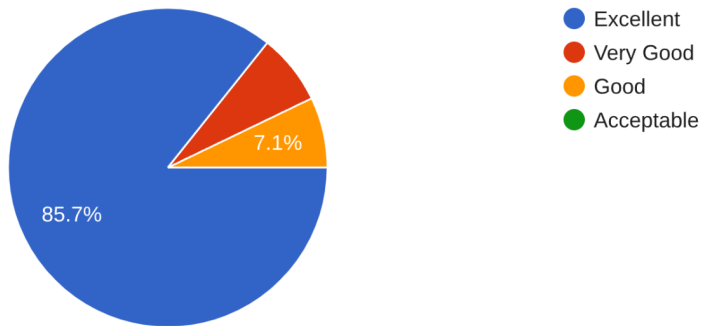

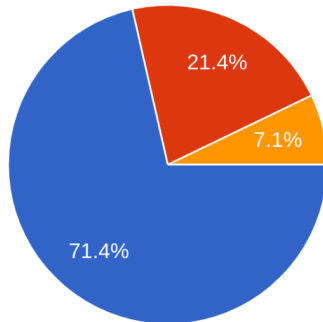

Pre-Arrangement Done for the event.

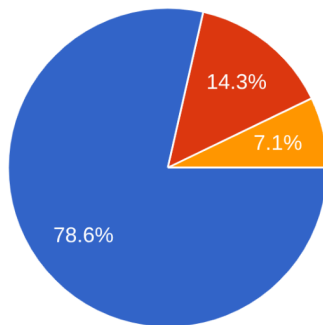

Arrangement done during the event

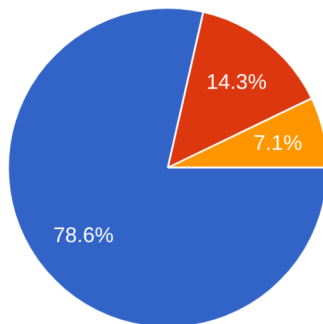

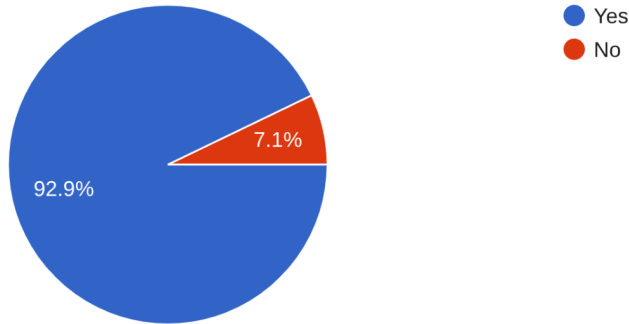
