This year our NSS volunteers went for a residential camp to our adopted village – Tandulwadi, wherein they did a commendable job. They engaged in distribution of Bedsheets, Soaps, Donation of footwear, toothbrush, toothpaste, chocolates and biscuits to school children, donation of cupboards, clothes, utensils, stationary, tables and chairs to school donation of chairs to the BAYAP Hall, donation of saris, towels and mats, sewing machines, and foodgrain to the villagers. This year we organised two National conferences. The college organized a National Seminar on REVISED ACCREDITATION FRAMEWORK BY NAAC on Saturday, 17th February, 2018. This seminar was organized for updating academicians about the revised framework and discussing the challenges before the institutions considering the new guidelines. The seminar was inaugurated at the hands of the Chief Guest - **Dr. Jagannath Patil, Adviser, National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore** and Guest of Honour **Dr. Smita Asthana Dean-Academics & IQAC Coordinator, St. Ann's College, Hyderabad, Telangana**. The Self Financed Section of our college in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell organized the UGC sponsored National conference on 'ICT for economic prosperity, Entrepreneurship, Good governance and Development' on 3rd March 2018.

The Self Finance Course and IQAC department of Prahladrai Dalmia Lions College of Commerce and Economics in association with the Board of Studies in Accountancy & Finance and Banking & Insurance organized a workshop in the College Campus on 15th July, 2017.

In keeping with the theme of the year, an inter-collegiate conference on 'Youth & Wellness: Body, Mind & Spirit' was organized on 22nd February, 2018 by the students of the Department of Business Communication under the aegis of IQAC. It was a conference organized 'by the students for the students' with an objective of understanding the importance of health which includes our body, mind & spirit. The BMM department organized an intercollegiate conference on the topic 'Gender on 15th March, 2018.

This year we had four in-house publications: Fare Forward- the newsletter of IQAC, Bulletin by the department of BMM called – 'SCOOP', Rainbow and D'LITA the e-magazine.

The Career Guidance Cell arranges for career guidance and the Placement Cell is proactive in getting companies of repute to the college campus so that our students can be well placed. **A Job Fair – DRISHTANT** was conducted by the Cell on 27th Feb 2017. We encourage our students to do internships at various reputed firms of Mumbai.

Our various extension units and associations are doing a commendable job and benefitting the society around us. A community project 'Ek Mutthi Anaj' was undertaken by college extension units in a village near Dahanu. I 300 kg of rice was donated by our students.

We now have a Zero Waste Campus project implemented in the college campus.

Through one of our best practices by the Department of Foundation Course this year too, 1100 students, visited 25 institutions such as orphanages, old age homes, homes for the disabled, the visually impaired and homes for kids with special needs, women, street children, etc. These visits have sharpened the social sensibilities of our students and have made them more aware and sensitive towards the weaker sections of our society.

We have organized a number of guest lectures, workshops, panel discussions, seminars for our students throughout the year.
