Activities conducted during the year by the department:

Curricular:

13th June, 2022- Lectures for third year students commenced in offline mode.

22nd June, 2022- Lectures for second year students commenced in offline mode.

26th July, 2022 - An intra collegiate quiz on occasion of “**Kargil Diwas**” was organised in association with Patriot Cell from 9.00am to 9.00 pm on 26/07/2022. The main purpose of this visit was to acquaint students with the struggles of life and problems of the elderly citizens. Sensitization of students regarding their responsibility towards their elders. Students were informed about the activity and interested students had to voluntarily register for the initiative via Google form. Students contributed via cash as well as in terms of their time. Some students as well as teachers contributed and collected Rs. 3600/- from which Adult Diapers were purchased and donated to Citizen’s Welfare Association (Citizen Care Centre, Old Age Home), Kandivali (W). 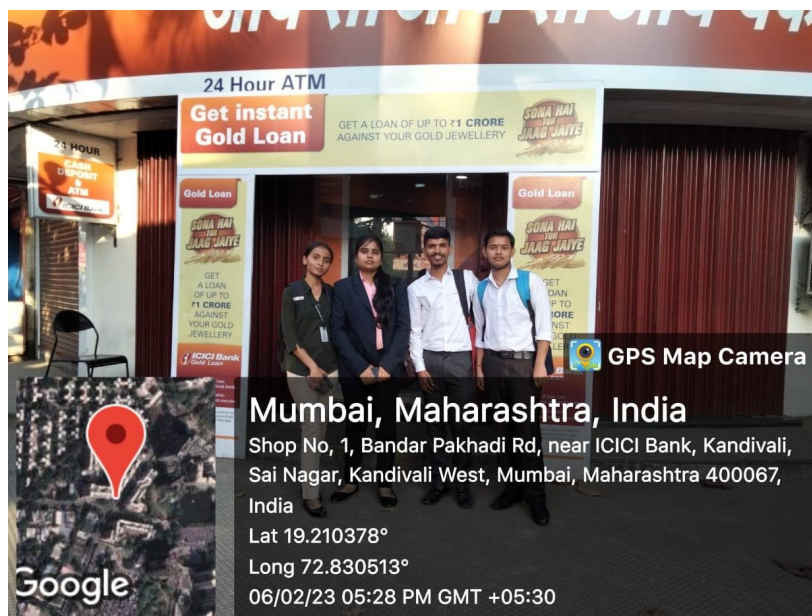
