The Department of Business Communication aims to enhance the Communication skills of its students. Apart from the teaching learning process that happens with reference to the subject of Business communication offered at the first year of the B.Com degree program the department makes efforts to instill in the students a love for language learning. Understanding communication theory, concepts, practice and skills definitely help students advance themselves. But practice in communication skills is a major requirement.

The Department provides students with opportunities to showcase and enhance their skills – reading, writing, listening and speaking skills.

Activities conducted during the year by the department:

Curricular:

Bridge Course in Communication Skills: A bridge course in communication skills was organized for students of FYBCom immediately after they took admission in the institution in the first week of July 2019.

Remedial lectures were organized for students who have failed in the subject in the previous years.

Online English Language Enhancement Course – ELEC: Using Google Classroom the department conducted an online English Language Enhancement Course from 9th May to 9th June 2020. 66 students enrolled for the course and 21 students successfully completed the course.

Extra-curricular:

Workshop on 'Read Fast and Learn More': The Dept. of Business Communication organized an informative workshop on 'Read Fast and Learn More" on Monday, 28th January 2020 at 10:30 am in the college auditorium. The workshop was conducted by Professor Rajesh Tayal, a student-guide and wellness instructor. Mr. Tayal enlightened the students with information on how to increase their reading speed by prescribing different methods and exercises to enhance their reading capabilities. He emphasized that a faster reading speed, makes learning faster and easier. With various exercises and activities, Prof. Tayal helped the students develop the ability of reading faster. More than 90 students attended the session and got a chance to learn the skill of reading fast.

A short basic course on Enhancement of Speaking Skills in English was organised in February 2020 for the students of FYBCom.

Student Research Conference: In the subject of Business communication we teach in detail Conferences. As part of experiential learning for the past years we give our students a hands on learning experience of organizing a conference themselves. This year too students were given an opportunity to conduct a research conference of the students by the students and for the students. The theme of the conference was: The Art and Science of Generosity. This topic was chosen in keeping with our theme of the year – The Art of Giving.
