This will enable the University to maintain uniform standards in the results.

With her wide experience, we are sure Dr. (Miss) Bangalee will be able to execute the duties in her new assignment with success and restore the prestige and glory of the University.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

We are pleased to present hereunder our report for the year 1985–86 which has been noteworthy in many respects. The atmosphere in the campus was extremely peaceful and congenial throughout. The teachers were motivated to shoulder responsibilities and they responded extremely well. Our students are very resourceful and have excellent organising abilities. Most of the functions were managed by them under the able guidance of our willing young teachers.

We sincerely thank our students for the reputation they have brought to our institution by their excellent moral behaviour and by their achievements.

Following the encouragement given by our Management with free and intensive coaching in the past, we have progressed academically as can be observed from the results at various examinations. At the Board Examination, our Junior College result was 93% with 271 passing in 1st Class, 396 in Second and only 18 in Pass Class. At the Degree level our result was 56% with 15 in First, 273 in Second and 160 students passing in Pass Class. We are not content with this achievement nor complacent and will endeavour to do better in coming years.

With the transfer of F. Y. and S. Y. Examinations by the University, we are burdened with additional responsibility of conducting examinations, which has become increasingly difficult in recent years. Nevertheless, our teachers have been doing a commendable job and our students have responded well to the Semester System.

INDEPENDENCE DAY: Lion President, J. P. BAIRAGRAJI, President of the Lions Club of Malad-Borivli unfurled the National Flag on 15th August, 1985 in presence of a largely attended meeting of Students – Teachers – Lion Members and the Governing Council Members. On the same day Hindi Sahitya Parishad inaugurated its activities by Quawali Mukabla between AZIZ NAZAN and BEGUM FARJANA TAJ.

students—teachers council: The elections were keenly contested as in the past. Mr. T. A. KHAN was elected as Chairman and Mr. SANJAY MAHESHWARI as General Secretary of the Council. The Council organised and successfull managed all functions such as Gymkhana Day, College Day etc. all on their own. They have maintained discipline and have given spectacular performance.

Planning Forum Dr. Rangnath Bharadwaj, Director of Department of Economics at the Bombay University and an eminent economist stressed on the need of planning for the development of a nation like India and on the importance of National spirit for the success of Economic planning.

Under the Chairmanship of Prof. A. R. Phophale and Secretary Mr. Iyer Subramaniam the Forum conducted various competitions in Essay Writing and in General knowledge.

A course in "Civil Defence" imparting lessons in First Aid, Fire Fighting, Ambulance Service, Time duties etc. is organised by the Forum. This course has become increasingly popular among the students and the successful ones will be awarded certificates.

LITERARY & DEBATING SOCIETY:

Participated successfully in various intercollegiate competitions and brought laurels to P. D. Lions College.

Mr. Sameer, a T. Y. B. Com. student secured Third Prize in Rangoli Competition. Our College Team won the third prize in QUIZ Competition organised by the Leo Club. Miss Shashi Lohia bagged the First Prize and Mr. Jhunjhunwala the Third Prize in inter-collegiate Essay Competition organised by U. S. S. R. Exhibition Committee.

The society organised in A. D. Shroff Memorial competition and conducted porgrammes in 'What's the Good Word' and QUIZ TIME. Miss Kanchan Gore bagged a prize as the 'Best Speaker' in the Inter-Collegiate Competition held at Chinai College Andheri,

N. S. S.: Traditionally P. D. Lions College has remained in the forefront of all social. activities. Having topped in collection for the Children Aid Society for three consecutive years the College has retained permanently the Sheriff Kantikumar Podar Trophy. At a function held at the Shanmukananda Hall last month, a large number of boys and girls of Dalmia College were given prizes by Mr. Kantikumar Podar for their individual performance. About 250 houses were surveyed by our students for vaccination, family planning etc. A visit of Mrs. Dr. G. Hans an eminent social worker of Tata Institute was arranged. She convincingly showed the advantages of family planning to the villagers.

A medical camp was organised with the assistance of Safale Health Centre where immunisation and vaccination programme was undertaken.

Our N. S. S. Boys organised a cultural programme to entertain the people and conducted competition in Kabaddi and other sports among the local population. A street play on Family Planning staged by our students was very popular and highly appreciated by the people.

Lion Madhu Maheshwariji visited the camp and guided the activities.

Planning & Economic Development

Planning is a pre-thought of course of action. "Look before you leap and think before you ink." Is the philosophy rightly said by wise elders. Economic development is a result of proper, efficient & systematic planning. Economic development means major changes in social institutions, peoples behaviour & attitude, the Social, political & economic dogmas, Increase in income & employment, improvement in standard living of the people, control of black money and inflation checking the growth of population and so on.

Thirty - Five years have passed, the Government of India has introduced the Planning Commission to control & requlate as well as check the country's over all economic development. Yet, much is to be achieved as the contry's GNP is still around 3.5% per year and nearly. 48% of

the people living in India are below the poverty line. It is through systematic layout of plans & strategies we can achieve development.

Priorities must be given to the agriculture and minary sector, the primary and secondary sectors as well. Since they are inter-related and count in the economic development of the nation. Natural resources must be utilised to the fullest extent as it is a god's gift. Besides this, labour is also a major factor which has to be trained and educated well. As it is the quality of the labour that helps development rather than its quantity. It is rightly said that "Capital is sterile without labour, but labour can climb mountains without capital". This emphasizes lhe intensity of labour.

Capital formation and accumulation is also an essential factor, in the development of the economy. The arrangement for collection of capital resources must be planned in advance.

Further, what follows next is to check the market economy and growing rate of inflation. The inflation rate is nearly around 5.6% which is high indeed.

In the Seventh five year plan. Our Planning Commission has laid emphasis on rationalisation & liberalisation of tax structure and its policies. As taxation is one of the source of public revenue. The government plans its expenditure in advance and then accordingly fixes the tatget of its collection of revenue through taxation. It is therefore clear that at every step of action, there must be prior preparation and planning in advance to get the desired results.

The government spends its revenue on public amenities, utilities and services on Railways, Road construction, Drinking water facilities, sanitation facilities and so on.

For economic development due consideration must be given to see to it that the country its self-reliant to certain extent. It must increase its exports inorder, to earn Foreign exchange. The planning commission has laid a target of 13% growth in export for the current plan.

Incentives must be given to start small scale industries inorder to reduce mass unemployment along with many tax conce ssions and facilities.

Developing the rural areas also count lot. The rural development programmes must include mass education, rural electrifi—

cation and also basic amenities of life must be made available.

The government must promote the savings rate. Incentives are given to mobilise the resources in the form of savings which will enhance development of the nation via production of goods & provision of services. The savings rate at present is around 22 to 23 %. It is estimated to reach at about 25% by the end of the Seventh plan.

Growing population must also be centred and given prime importance. The birth rate must be controlled through the means of educating people and giving them imformation of family planning by the way of Media, lectures and so on.

Thus, economic development of a country involves the overall development of a nation in agriculture, technology etc. Technological progress must be given importance inorder to keep pace with the development of other nations. The old techniques which become obsolete must be replaced by new methods of production and technical organisation.

To sum up, from the starting till the end, proper planning and estimation is of prime importance to achieve the economous development of a country. In India since it is a developing country, there is much undone. Let's hope to acquire economic development within a short period through efficient planning system of our government as Rajiv Gandhi, our Prime Minister has said that his Government is a Government Which works faster.

Books help make a hostile world friendly, a cold word cozy. Through them you may have Dickens as a nextdoor neighbour Maik Twain as a friend always ready to drop in for a fireside chat; Willa Cather as the companion of long winter evenings Reading gives you instant access to the worlds

noblest spirits and greatest hearts; to the most eloquent voices, the wisest minds, the most senene counsellors and the gayest comrades. Reading is the most innocent type of pleasure; if it is well trained and well directed. But flashy, silly and immoral books and magazines corrupt the minds of the young people. Good reading admits us

to the company of the noblest and the best minds of all ages. By reading good books "we take delight in weal and seek relief in woe". In moments of dejection and depression, reading soothes and consoles our troubled souls. Good books on religion uplift our souls to celestial heights and have the most reassuring and soothing effect on our troubled minds.

POVERTY LINE

(Miss) Kanchan S. Gore F. Y. B. Com.

Poverty is a curse to adeveloping country like India. Relative poverty is something that can be coped up with. But we have mass poverty in our country. This is a constant source of anxiety to us.

Poverty can be described as a social phenomenon where in, a section of the society is not in a position to satisfy their basic requirements. In India, we are more concerned with minimum needs rether than reasonable standard. We are not in a position to supply even minimum needs so to think about reasonable standard would be wishful thinking.

Poverty in Indian concept is different from poverty in American or other developed country's concept. In America there is relative poverty, According to American standards, 99% of our population is poor so, we cannot think in their terms.

It is expected that every Indian should know atleast something about the economic condition of our country, so, to understand the extent of poverty in our country, the concept of poverty line has been exotred. This concept is related to the consumption expenditure.

Special efforts have been taken by our government, the planning commission & some individual economists to know the extend of porerty in India.

According to the planning commission Rs. 20 /- monthly per capita consumer expenditure at 1960-61 prices, is the poverty line. According to this estimation: 50% of population was below the porerty line.

Prof. Y. M. Dandekar & N. Rath consider an intake of 2250 caloris from food per day as sufficient in India, both in urban & rural areas. They said that at 1960-61

prices, Rs. 15/- in rural & Rs. 22.50/- in urban areas should be the poverty line. As per their estimates, 40% of rural & 50% of urban population lived below this poverty line.

Another distinguished economist Bardhan made some studies in 1974. He siad that Rs. 15 /- in rural & Rs. 18 /- in urban areas should determine the poverty line. His estimation that 54% of rural & 41% of urban population is poor is just the reverse to that of Prof. Dandekar & Rath.

Fourthly, Sukhatme, another economist argued that, 1687.5 cal. i.e. 76% of 2250 cal. should be considered as the poverty line.

So economists are not sure about the calorie norm. Poof Dandekar & Rath concentrated on food—grains only on which 60% of consumer's ezpenditure is spent. They concentrated on corbohydrates which provide us calories. But Sukhatine argued that it is the protein deficiency that loads to under—nutrition in India.

So even after a lot of contemplating, among economists, there is endless quibbling debate which continues, about the nutritional norm. The matters of nutrition should be left to the nutritional experts. Today, economicts should concentrate on consumer behavious instead.

According to the 1979-80 prices, the planning commission said that, Rs. 76/- in rural & Rs. 88/- in urban areas monthly per capita consumer expenditure should be the

poverty line. As per this estimate, 50.7% of rural & 40 % of urban population lived below the poverty line. According to the recent figures supplied by the government, 37% of our population still lives below the poverty line by 1983-84.

In India, fluctuations in agriculture have always determined poverty. With other factors, failure in agriculture increased poverty.

The calorie norm is based on intake measurement. It is not output or result oriented. Are we capable enough to generate any more economic values, if, the food intake is given, to remove poverty and malnutrition? Even if poverty is removed, the value added by the poor would not be worth.

Our body is physiologically autoregressive. The calories derived by every person depends on his body constitution & ecological factors. So, subsequent calarie measurement is not enough to determine poverty.

The planning commission had introduced. 'The Mtnimum Needs Programme' during the 5th & 6th Five year plans. but it was not implemented seriously.

Today, equal distribution of factors of production is not possible. If income is transferred to the poor, it will emage back to the factory owners ie the rich class. Today, the statistics seem very depressing. It seems that we are not able to cope up with the problem of poverty. Let us hope that the sayings like 'Try & Try till you succeed', give us motivation to figet this problem.

The Growing Menace of Drug Addiction

An epidemic of herion addiction is sweeping through the country. It has hit almost every section of the society—students, young professionals, Taxi Drivers, petty vendors and even government officals. In India, till recently it was believed that drug addiction was a problem faced by the western countries and that India was virtually free from this menace. Three years ago hardly any one heard of addicts but today it has became No. 1 problem of the country concerning the Government, psychiatrist and social workers.

Where as in the 1970's it was ganja, hashish and LSD that were a rage among addicts, herion and a cruder form of herion called smack has become one of the most widely used drug. When the acrid fumes of herion or smack are inhaled either through a cigarette or chasing it (a fascinating technique by which powdered smack is placed on a silver foil and heated and its vapours inhaled through a pipe). The user feels immediate rush of exhilaration. Initially, herion gives the user a feeling of well being & even increases his sexual appetite but within six months its ill effects starts showing in loss of weight and weakness, lungs could

become congested, and heart lining is infected and gastric problems are frequent. An over dose of herion could even kill. It is difficult to detect a drug addict except that the pupils of the drug addict eyes remains pinpoint even at night. But there is marked change in his behaviour. He usually become an introvert, living in his own fantasy world, and becomes restless and irritable once the effect of the drug wears off. Once a person get hooked he has to have his daily dose other wise he would suffer withdrawal symptoms. The symptoms, known as clod turkey leads to addicts eyes watering profusely sweating and severe body pain.

Police intelligence puts the number of addicts in the country at 1 Lakh which is an conservative count. This figure is increasing at the rate of 15000 per year! Why has it assumed such a dimension.

Let us analyse this question?

One of the reasons is that the impure form of herion called smack has become available at low price. It is so freely and cheaply available because India has become a major transit centre for herion smuggling. Herion is smuggled in to India from Pakistan through the porous border of Punjab & Rajasthan and then smuggled out again to Europe from Bombay and Delhi.

College students, where a drug subculture has always existed take up the habit as a fashion. Smoking in group but latter getting hooked to drugs individually. Psychi atrist put this problem to the breaking up if traditional social values and controls leading to an unusally degree. If stress on childrens, who take to Tobacco alcohol and finally to lighten the stress, at a tender age. The remedy for this situation is that the Government would have to be involved in a big way but it has done precious little to alleviate the problem. The Government Hospitals are woefully short of facilities to help the addicts and rehabilitate them the alternative is to establish independent rehabilitation centre which has not taken off in our country. But fortunately the Government the administration and the police have worken up to the problem and measures have been taken to combat the menace like the Narcotic Drugs and psychotypic substance act passed last year.

Although it may be said that drug addiction is here to stay, but it can be checked and steep rise in addiction stopped.

National Service Scheme unit of our College has became institution within institution. It is largely developed and widely recognised as the best unit not only in the Western Suburbs but whole of University of Bombay.

N. S. S. unit of our College dose not instill only social awarness in the minds of the students of our College but also provides practical filed work to the young generation. It has produced several social active field workers since last 14 years.

The students of our college since the inception of our N. S. S unit i.e. from 1972 till today have been giving tremendous response by taking active part in the various activities conducted by our N. S. S. unit.

Our unit earned best name in the University of Bombay and bagged 1st Prize for its excellent performance and yeomen service rendered during the last academic year

During the current academic year i. e. 1985–86. The N. S. S. unit of our College has registered 450 Volunteers out of which more than 200 have completed more than 120 hours Ten N. S. S. Volunteers have completed more than 500 hours. During the current academic year, Our N.S.S. unit has under taken following important activities

a) Tree Plantation Programme

This year the N. S. S. activities began with the Tree Plantation Programme. infact our experience with reference to tree plantation in the past was not satisfactory. Yet some of our N.S.S. Volunteers underwent Orientation programme on Tree Plantaion organised by the N. S. S. Co – ordinator a Vidyanagari Campus. Therefore our unit undertook tree plantation project only at selected places viz at Goregaon and Malad. Over 150 Samplings were planted by our N.S.S. Volunteers. It is indeed pleasure to see them fast growing.

b) Fund Collection Drive

N. S. S. unit of our college is widely recognised as the best unit in the University of Bombay for its fund raising activities.

This unit since last four years has been doing remarkable achievements in fund collection drives. It has made a 'Hat-trick' in receiving prestigious "Sheriff Kantikumar Podar Trophy" for highest fund collection for Children Aid Society. And at last the same Trophy is retained permanently by our unit.

Is there a better achievement than this? This indeed speaks our efforts to enthusiam and zeal for human cause.

During the current academic year the unit is actively involved in collecting funds for (1) the Children Aid society (2) Vice Chancellor's fund (3) National Association for the Blind (4) Knit India Organised by our national leader Padmashree Baba Amte. (5) Construction of Community Hall for Adivasis of Tandulwadi Village an adopted Village of our unit.

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We are indeed happy to mention the amount that our units have collected fund for the there noble purposes.

- 1. This year the total fund collection for Children Aid Society is Rs. 24000/- through advertisements for which. Our unit received 1st Prize in Certificate and Rs. 15000/- through sale of Coupons.
- 2. Rs. 3400/- for the National Association for Blind for which our unit received a shield.
- 3. Rs. 400/- were Collected within a day by our N. S. S. Volunteer for Kint India Movement organised by Padmashree Baba Amte.
- 4. Rs. 10,000/- were collected for providing financial assistance to the Children of class IV Employees of University of Bombay & Colleges which is known as V.C. Fund.
- 5. Rs. 5000/— so far collected for constructions of Community Hall at Tandulwadi Village for Adivasi Community.

This figure is enough to show the awarnes of our N. S. S. volunteers towards the down trodden Community.

c) Resource Mobilisation Project

Some of our N.S.S. Volunteers visited David Sasoon Industrial Home at Matunga, to work and play with inmates for whom they have been collecting funds.

d) Blood Donation Drive

- d) Another significant activity which has been performed by our N. S. S. unit every academic year is Blood donation drive.
- The N. S. S. unit of our College in Collaboration with Lion's Club of Malad—Borivli organised two Blood Donation Drives respectively 1st and 1Ind Term of 1985—86. In first drive 205 bottles of blood were Collected and during second drive 100 bottles. It is needless to say that students of our college and N. S. S. Volunteers of our units have given tremendous response by taking active part in this activity.

e) The S. U. B. B. Project

The student for Better Bombay Project introduced by the then Commissioner of Police, Greater Bombay. Mr. Ribeiro this project was successfully undertaken by our enthusiastic N.S.S. Volunteers.. This Project is known as "Police – Student Interaction Programme" in which Police Force participation in liaison with the help of Police Officer and other Constables about 150 N.S.S. Volunteers have actively participated and involved in this Project.

The project includes dutis on 'Bus Stop' during peak hours specially morning 7 to 9.00 a.m. and evening 5 to 7 p.m. Duties such as maintaining Bus ques and educating the public the importance of 'Ques' to avoid inconvenience.

Our N.S.S. Volunteers were posted at Malvani Bus Stops, Malad Bus Stops. They received overwhelming response by Malvani and Malad Bus Commuters. Besides our N.S.S. Volunteers assisted the Police in Traffic Control as well as regulating crowd specially during Festivals such as Loard Ganpati and Gauri immersion.

Our N.S.S. Volunteers are every year invited by the Chief Priest of Erangal Church for controlling and regulating the Crowd during the Fair

f) (i) Malvani K.E.M. Hospital Project

The N. S. S. Volunteers of our units have been rendering Social and Medical Services at Malvani K. E. M. Hospital Nearly 100 N.S.S. Volunteers daily perform various duties at Malvani Hospial such as (a) Conducting Medical Survey viz, T. B., Leprosey Blindness etc. (b) acting as link between the Patients and Medical practioners as well as Medical Social Workers.

g) Health Survey

Our N. S. S. Volunteers participated in finding out the Patients suffering from diseases of the surronding areas of Malvani Village Malad and directing them to K. E. M. Health Centre for further treatment.

(ii) Malvani School Project

Nearly 100 N. S. S. Volunteers of our units are actively involved in Malvani School Project. Our N. S. S. Volunteers daily visit to Primary School at Malvani and conduct remedial Classes. Furthermore they also conduct a survey of dropout in School.

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h) Follow-up Survey

About 15 N. S. S Volunteers were involved in finding out School dropout of the Children of the Class IV Employees. These Children are provided sets of books and other materials with the help from the N.S.S. unit of the University of Bombay.

i) RURAL PROJECT

N. S. S. unit of our College in Collaboration with Lions Club of Malad - Borivli have been working at Tadulwadi Village 10 Kilometers away from Safali Railway Station in District of Thana since last seven years.

Tandulwadi Village is an adopted Village of our N. S. S. unit is predominantly inhabited by the Adivasis viz warlis. This Community is practically denied Medical facilities, and other basic necessitics of life.

Today, the Villagers of Tandulwadi and surrounding Villages area vailing of Medical help from the "Mathushri Ladhidevi Ramdhar Maheshwari Hospital", which is constructed by Lion Madhu Maheswari in Collaboration with Lions Club of Malad-Borivli. Two Medical Practitioners viz Dr. (Mrs.) Desai and Dr. Dedhia, four times in a week visit the Hospital and provide Medical assistance to the Villagers.

The N. S. S. Volunteers during their ten days Camp Conducted the Medical survey of Tandulwadi and detented the patients suffering from diseases such as T. B. Leprosy Matnutrition etc. and submitted the report to these medical practitioners for further Treatment.

The N. S. S. Volunteers of our units are activity involved through out the year in this project.

Y. F. R. R. Camp-Tandulwadi

In the Current academic year, 10 days Y.F.R.R. Camp was organised in the month of December at Tandulwadi Village.

Forty two of our N. S. S. Volunteers and two Programme Officers attended this camp. The following activities were under taken during there periods.

i) Medical survey

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Medical survey was conducted and report was submitted to the B. D. O. and Medical Officer at Palghar and Primary Medical Health Centre at Safali.

ii) Vaccination and Immumisahor Programme

Programme with the help of Safale Primary Health Centre, Safali was conducted at Tandulwadi Village.

iii) Medical Check up Programme

Was conducted with the help of Safale Primary Helth Centre. N. S. S. Volunteers cum campers took special efforts to bring the patients from different Padas of the Villege as well as helping the medical practitioners to check the patients.

d) Nutrition Education

The N. S. S. Volunteers cum campers have conducted Nutrition Education Programme in different Paddas of Tandulwadi. They visited each household and certain

common instructions were imparted by them to the members of each family. Instructions regarding their nutritional care, treatment at Primary level. During the sickness of their Children specially diarrhoea, dysentry, dehydration, scabies etc.

- ii) Food habits such as Food Recommended-Food avoided for Infants, Pregnent Women, Lactating Mothers, the reproductive age group, Girls/Women in general.
 - iii) Infant care.
- iv) Demonstration of Kitchen Gardening practical education of producing food at homelevel through kitchen gardening was imparted by our N. S. S. Volunteers at Tandulwadi School Premises and Certain households of differents Paddas.

e) Contact with Village Workers

Y.F.R.R. camp leaders Contacted wth Village workers to enquire the availability of Integrated Child Development Services (I.C.D.S.) Project.

The I. C. D. S. provides services such as supplementary nutrition food, immunist—tion health check—up and nonformal education for childern in the age group of 0 to 6 yrs. etc.

f) Remedial Classes

Marathi speaking N. S. S. Volunteers Conducted remedial classes at Tandulwadi Primary School for the school childern as well as the children of the Adivasis commuunity. They imparted education on clean liness, including nail cutting, Health, Sanitation, Drinking Water and other subjects.

g) Orientation of N.S.S. Volunteers

At camp sight orientation of 42 N.S.S Volunteers was conducted. B. D. O. Shri A. M. Azeam was invited to orient our N.S.S.

Volunteers. Shri Azeam was kind enough to deliver lecture to our N. S. S. Volunteers. In his lectures, he mentioned various Socio-economic measures undertaken by the Government specially at District level.

At the same time Villages were also invited to attend the meeting to express their problems and findout solution at B.D.O level. It was indeed nice meeting B. D. O. and Villagers

h) Special Invities

In order to orient our N. S. S. Volunteers, Prof. (Mrs.) Gurumit Hans, Acting Head of N.S.S. unit of Tata Social Institute was invited at Y. F. R. R. camp she delivered lecture on [i] Immunisation. [ii] Nutrition, Education and other N. S. S. activites which N. S. S. Volunteers should under take.

Principal (Mrs.) P. S. Baleri also visited Y. F. R. R. camp to neourage & guide our N. S. S. Volunteers.

For First time at our Y. F. R. R. camp 15 N. S. S. Volunteers performed a street play on Family Planning. It was nicely organised and conducted by one of our N.S.S. Secretaries Shri Harshanand Sangveker The street Play was also performed in different Paddas of Tandulwadi Village. It was very well received and appriciated by the Villagers.

The N. S. S. Voluntaers at Tandulwadi Village had organised Sports for (1) Youth of the Village (2) Children of Adivasis and (3) Tandulwadi School Children.

Kabbadi

Six Teams of Tandulwadi and Surrounding Villages participated in Kabbadi Competition which was organised by our N.S.S.

Volunteers Infact two Sirpanchas viz Tandulwadi Village and Larttan Village participated in Kabbadi competition.

Tandulwadi Adivasi Team secured 1st Prize and Larttan Village secured 2nd prize. Field Work

The N. S. S. Volunteers were actively involved in manual work specially from morning 7 a.m. to 11-45 a.m. such as levelling of the Tandulwadi school ground, to enable the local students to have a good play ground.

Cultural Programme

The N. S. S. Volunteers at Y. F. R. R. Camp also conducted various cultural activities in order to the entertained adivasis.

Cultural Programme such as coaching the children of Adivasis in dance, singing, reciting poetry, folk dance etc. by N. S. S. Volunteers.

Our N. S. S. unit is greatful and thank ful to Shri A. M. Azeam B. D. O. Palghar Prof. (Mrs.) Gurumit Hans, for Sirpanch of Tandulwadi. Shri Rama Kavli, Lion Madhu Maheswari, Principal (Mrs.) P. S. Baleri, Medical Officer, Primary Health Centre, Safale, for accepting our invitation and to bwith us at Y. F. R. R. camp.


Three of our N. S. S. Volunteers have under gone orientation on agriculture at Dapoli which was organised by the University of Bombay.
