The Department of Business Law is a single faculty member department. It caters to all students of First Year B.com and Second Year B.Com. On average there are about 840 and 720 students respectively taking the course every year. The subject of Business Law is a major component of the Bachelor of Commerce Degree program. The subject is taught at the First Year (NEP) and Second year Degree course as a compulsory subject for the Degree of Commerce.

The aims and objectives of the department of business law are to provide a clear understanding, describe and explain various legal concepts of Commercial Law and to orient students, about the legal aspects of Trade and Commerce. Further is aims to provide the brief idea about the framework and other parameters of Indian Partnership Act, Sale of Goods Act , Negotiable Instrument Act, Indian Companies Act etc. To familiarize the students with case law studies related to Business Laws at the Second Year Level and to make aware the students about the framework of Indian Constitution and its various components at the F.Y.Bcom Level. We also aim to provide an intensive coaching centre for students to prepare them for law courses. We arrange visits to High Court and Consumer Courts at the end semester. Teaching is conducted via Case Studies, Problem Solving Method, and Visits.

The Department with its one faculty member has strength of 720 students and 6 divisions. And 840 students at F.YBcom It offers three papers paper as 'Business Law' in the Semester III and IV comprising with different Acts which includes all the commercial laws viz., Indian Contract Act, The Sale of goods Act, The Negotiable Instrument (Amendment) Act 2015, Indian Companies Act, Indian Partnership Act, Consumer Protection Act and Competition Act, Limited
