Curricular Activities:

- Department had organized guest lecture on "Negotiable Instrument Act" at college auditorium on 17th October, 2019 by Dr. Deepa Chitnis, Associate Professor-NarsiMonji College of Commerce and Management Vile Parle (NMIMS). 149 students of S.Y.B.com had benefited out of this lecture. Dr. Deepa Chitnis had shared her experiences in respect of Negotiable Instruments; she had also shared recent amendments in Negotiable Instrument Act.
- Group Discussion was conducted in the class room. Students were told to prepare on a particular case studies and they discussed. Individual students were called defend the case in front of the class. It helped in learning more about the topic and which increases students understanding of a subject or a lesson, it helps in generating more ideas about a topic.
