



Ever since an excerpt from the book, Battle Hymn of the Tiger Mom, appeared in the Wall Street Journal under the provocative title 'Why Chinese Moms are Superior' there has been a debate, particularly in the western media, about the proto-Fascist parenting techniques described by writer Amy chua. But while western mothers have expressed shock, there has been a quiet chortle of understanding here in India. Many Shrerni mothers not only emphathise, they cheers. Yes! At least, someone who is on the same wavelength as us. These Indian moms can be seen everywhere, ensuring that their child is a combination of Einstein, Sachin Tendulkar, Bobby Fischer, Picasso and Yehudi Menuhin. Not to forget Bill Gates.

So we've got the picture of the Indian Tiger Mom (ITM), the one species not likely to go extinct anytime soon. But what about the father? What does he think of all this (assuming he thinks independently)? For argument's sake, we will assume the father too have some thoughts on the subject. Occasionally he bleats out his views.





It has been said that mosquitoes cause more human suffering than any other organism- over one million people worldwide die from mosquito borne diseases every year. There are 3,000 species of mosquitoes, but the members of three bear primary responsibility for the spread of human diseases: Anopheles, Culex and Aedes spp. Here are some parasitic and viral diseases that humans can contract from a mosquito bite.

Malaria- Malaria is caused by a parasite called Plasmodium, which is transmitted via the bites of infe led Anopheles Mosquitoes. In the human body, the parasites multiply in the liver, and then infect red blood cells in 2013 an estimated 198 million cases of malaria occurred worldwide and 500'000 people died. Mostly children in the African region. Symptoms of malaria include fever, headache, and vomiting, and usually appear between and 15 days after the mosquito bite. If not treated, malaria can quickly become life- threatening by disrupting the blood supply to the vital organs.

Dengue fever- Dengue virus is transmitted by female mosquitos mainly of the species Aedes aegypti and to lesser extent, A, albopictus. As many as 400 million people are infected yearly. Dengue is caused by any one of four related viruses transmitted by mosquitos. The principal symptom of dengue are high fever, severe headache, severe pain behind the eyes, joint pain, muscle and bone pain rashes and mild bleeding (e.g. nose or guns bleed, easy bruising).

Chikungunya- Chikungunya is is a mosquito bome virus that has been identified in over 60 countries in Asia, Europe and America. Chikungunya is a viral disease transmitted by the bite of infected mosquitos such as Aedes aegypti Aedes albopictus. It can cause high fever, joint and muscle pain and headache.
