Balancing studies and rap has been challenging, but I take both seriously. My rap journey has been guided by two mentors I look up to: Emiway Bantai and Divine.

I am grateful for the good things in my life—my family, who constantly supports me; my teachers, who are proud of my progress; and my friends, who cheer for me and stand by me every time I perform on stage.

My first major achievement came with Shubham at the Guthli event at St. Xavier's College, where we won two prizes for rap and beatboxing. Since then, I have continued winning: two prizes at the Mukam event, two prizes at the Udhaan event, and one prize in Udhaan Got Talent. One of my proudest contributions was creating a title track for my college's inter-college festival, DLU—a first for our institution.


