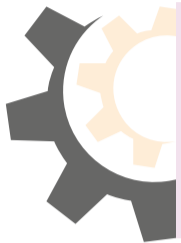

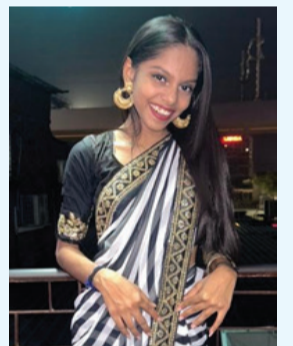


## DANCING TO THE NATIONAL RHYTHM

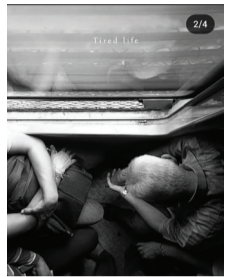
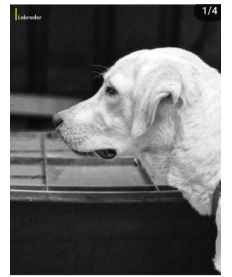
## LMC DEADPOOL SINCE 14: UNDERGROUND TO FOREGROUND A JOURNEY

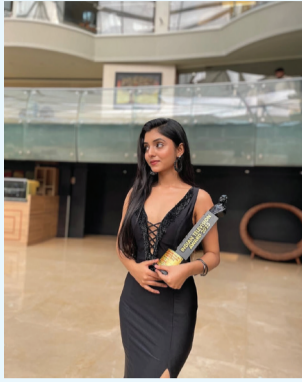
