‘Man se Man Ki Baat’

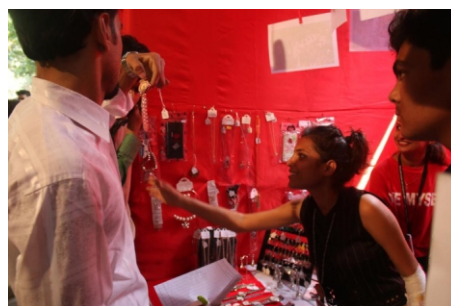
