The Chief Guest and key note speaker of the **inauguration ceremony** was Ms. Sangeetha Godbole, Director General, Indian Revenue Services. The Guest of honour was Mr Krishna Prakash, VIP Security, Indian Police Service. Honourable Lion Sharad Ruia Chairman Governing Council and Lion Kanahaiyal Saraf – honorary Secretary, Governing council were also present in the Seminar.
