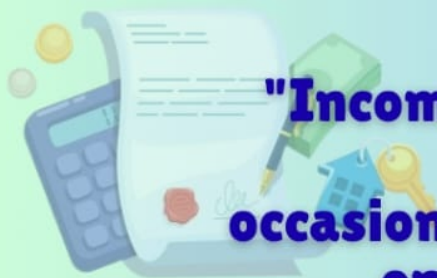

Objectives of the Event




- To provide students with **practical knowledge of income tax concepts**, including filing returns, deductions, and compliance.
