# Workshop on Disaster Preparedness

On 3rd and 4th September a district level two day workshop on 'Disaster Preparedness' was organised jointly by the NSS unit of our college and the Disaster Management Unit of the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM). Lion Kanahaiyalal G. Saraf, Hon. Secretary of the Governing Council was the Chief Guest. The resource persons for the workshop were Mr. Rajendra Lokhande, Shift In-Charge, Disaster Management Unit, MCGM; Dr. Deepak Dalvi, practicing doctor and team member of the Disaster Management Unit and Mr.Wadekar from Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport (BEST).

Mr. Rajendra Lokhande explained the concept of 'disaster', do's and dont's of natural and manmade disasters, plan for Mumbai by the Disaster Management unit through power point presentation. His session was an interactive one.

Dr. Deepak Dalvi, practicing doctor and team member of the Disaster Management unit explained the principles of First Aid, its contents, type of injuries, signs, symptoms, and treatment. He gave a demonstration of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).

On 2nd January a Poster making and Essay writing competition was organised for the college students. The topics were related to social issues. 45 students participated and 20 volunteers conducted the activity.

From 6th to 12th January a seven day residential camp was conducted at Vikramgad *Ashramshala*. 68 volunteers with 2 Program Officers – Dr. Swati Desai and Prof. Rajesh Bombe – participated in the camp.

The activities conducted were - Construction of Nullah, Tree Plantation, Health Check-up camp, Cleanliness drive and Awareness of *Andhashraddha Nirmulan*. They also assisted in the 'Distribution of Blankets, Notebooks, Educational kits' program organised by Lions Club of Malad - Borivli to *Ashramshala* pupils. In all, 530 blankets, 2000 notebooks and 500 educational kits were distributed. The number of beneficiaries of Health Check-up Camp was 115. 10 saplings were also planted in the school campus.

On 5th February Demonstration by IVBI was held. It was a part of the Voters Registration Drive. The Voters Registration activity was conducted on a continuous basis from August 2013. A survey was conducted between 19th August to 15th September 2013 in EP-1 to 16 to create an awareness regarding the registration. NSS volunteers assisted Mr. Vagal to complete the registration process. The process was conducted in college campus from 16th September to 27th October. 750 voters registered from the college campus, while approximately 1000 took forms and submitted in the Election office directly. 200 forms are under process.

On 6th February a Blood Donation/Thalessemia Testing/HBS Testing Drive was organised by the college NSS unit jointly with the Lions Club of Malad-Borivli. The Blood Bank belonged to J.J. Hospital Mumbai, SBTC. The Drive was inaugurated by Lion Shri Singhania by lighting the lamp. Lion K. G. Saraf, Hon. Secretary of Governing Council, Lion Vikas K. Saraf, Joint Secretary of Governing

Council, Lion Shri Tibrewal, President of Lions Club of Malad-Borivali, Lion Shri Kamal Ruia, Trustee, Lion Shri Atit Ruia and other Lions Club members, Principal Dr. N. N. Pandey, Vice Principal Prof. S.V. Chandratre, NSS Program Officers Dr. Swati Desai, Prof. Rajesh Bombe, Dr. Sunita Tidke, Prof. Sachin Bansode were present for the inauguration. Lion Shri Vikas Saraf kicked off the Blood Donation Drive by being the 1st donor of the day. Prof. Shami Nimqulkar-Kamble, also participated in Blood Donation. The staff members - Prof. S. A. Mandavawalla, Prof. S. N Hatekar, Prof. Shami Kambale, Prof. Kiran Mane, Prof. Shiva Padme, Prof. Rajesh Ruke, Prof. Sneha Sahu remained present. This encouraged the blood donors and the NSS volunteers. Ex-NSS volunteers, members of the Dalmia Campus Club and other students made the event successful. The total number of blood units collected were: 150; patients tested for thalassaemia were: 250 and HBS testing were: 286.

On 19th February Prof. Sachin Bansode and 18 NSS volunteers actively participated in the Youth Parliament organised by St. Xaviers College.

On 21st February a Street Play on Cleanliness was performed at Goregaon Street Play competition. On the same day Dr. Swati Desai attended the ceremony of launching a National Youth Policy organised by K. J. Somaiyya College. From 12th February onwards Dr. Swati Desai attended the session of Scrutiny of 10 marks at Thakur College in the capacity of Area Co-ordinator.

Other than the above activities our volunteers took part in projects organised by *Yuvak Biradari*. The number of volunteers registered were 10. On 1st July the Group Leaders Meeting at the Yuvak Biradari's Office took place. A Tree Plantation Abhiyann called – *Ek Sur Ek Taal Abhiyaan* was also held the same day. A session by Mr. Swar Kranti Shah followed by group discussion on pertinent issues were held prior to the tree plantation at the New-Zealand hostel in Aarey colony, Goregaon.

On the occasion of the *August Kranti Din a Prabhat Pheri*, a Peace Rally was organised wherein 15 volunteers participated. Around 20 colleges participated in this rally. The rally started from Mani Bhavan and ended at August Kranti Maidan, Grant Road. At Mani Bhavan volunteers visited an exhibition based on Gandhiji's life and values. Gandhiji's struggle was narrated through tiny models kept on display.

Mumbai Bhushan – Housing Society Competition: From 1st to 21st our volunteers participated in the *Mumbai Bhushan – Housing Society* Competition wherein the volunteers visited a number of Housing Societies and rated them on a 1 to 10 scale that contained criteria with regards to water management, energy saving etc. Based on these ratings the Yuvak Biradari selected the best society and a certificate of appreciation was thereby given to the concerned society. Our volunteers visited 43 societies as part of this project.

Udaan Leadership Training Camp: From 21st September to 24th October NSS volunteers attended the Udaan Leadership Training Camp.

Residential camp: From 25th to 27th October 4 volunteers of our College were selected at the 3 day residential camp at Mahavir Nagar, Chincholi (Dist. Thane). The volunteers selected were: Rashmi Poojary, Tejal Mohite, Apurva Shitkar, and Omkar Tari.

The following sessions on various themes by well known personalities were held:
