- Activities which took place there were construction of unbuilt road, wall painting, mandir cleaning, tree plantation, distribution of colthes, food grains and day to day needy things to the old people living their. A program was organised by the lions club of Malad-Borivli of distribution of blankets', solar lights, a short magic show and a free Medical Check-up Camp for the nearby villagers.

A major event which took place on 15th January, Road Safety Bike Rally with Mumbai Traffic police in which a huge number of our students supported them (80 volunteers). Meanwhile 8 of our volunteers went for Mahasuryakumbh.
- 24th January, 6 of our volunteers went for Convocation at the University of Mumbai.
- We had the Flag Hoisting ceremony on 26th January, Republic Day in which we took part with 26 volunteers.
