



National Service Scheme (NSS)



The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are to inculcate in the youth the understanding of the community in which they work and themselves in relation to their community; identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving; develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility; utilise their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems; develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities; gain skills in mobilising community participation; acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes; develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and practise national integration and social harmony.

Keeping in mind the above aims the activities for the year 2016-17 were planned and began from May 2016.

World Environment Day

On 5th June 2016 on the occasion of World Environment Day NSS unit organized a program in which they planted 25 plants in the college premises. Our 14 Volunteers participated in this programme. They also planted 28 plants in the Malad area near to college and also encouraged the public to grow more number of plants in their home.

Health Checkup Camp at Tandulwadi

On 13th June 2016 NSS unit organized a health check up camp at Tandulwadi in which they checked the dental health of the villagers. 45 villagers were beneficiaries because of this checkup. Our 18 volunteers made this event successful.



Yoga Day

On 21st June which is celebrated as World Yoga Day Mumbai University organized a 7 day non-residential camp in which our volunteers participated. From our unit 2 volunteers went for the event. The event was from 15th June to 21st June. On 21st June our NSS Unit celebrated Yoga Day in college. 64 NSS volunteers participated in this event. Dr. Sunita Tidke was in-charge of this event. On the same day our NSS unit celebrated Yoga Day at Tandulwadi Saphale. 14 volunteers participated wherein they taught yoga to the villagers. Prof. Rajesh Bombe was in-charge of this event.

Anti-Narcotics

On 26th June 2016 our NSS unit organized a seminar on Anti-Narcotics. The Mumbai Police and a Team of Anti-Narcotics came to the auditorium to teach us about the Anti narcotics. A skit was performed by the group of volunteers which showed the effects of drug addiction. Through a presentation and videos the youth were made aware of the problems related to drug addiction. 80 NSS volunteers made this event successful.

Health Checkup

Our NSS Unit had organized a Health Checkup for the staff members of the college in which they checked their blood pressure, sugar level, dental and BMI of the members. In which around 60 members came for the health checkup.



Orientation

On 2nd and 4th August 1st and 2nd Orientation Program kept for the 1st year volunteers for 1st and 2nd batch (125 volunteers) in which our programme officer inducted the volunteers upon the NSS program.

Kranti Divas : 50 volunteers participated in the Kranti Divas organised by the University of Mumbai at August Kranti maidan, Grant Road on 9th August 2016. The Chief Guest for this event was our Chief Minister Sri Devendra Fadnavis who spoke about Freedom Fighters and his contribution towards our nation.

Swachhta Pakhwada: On 12th August Swachhta Pakhwada was conducted in collaboration of NCC Students in which area was cleaned near the college surrounding.

Dengue Awareness: On 13th August a seminar was conducted regarding Dengue Awareness by the NSS Unit in college Auditorium in which 68 volunteers were active participants in feedback session. On 14th August a Rally was also organised and a BMC member was called for Fogging the area in order to control Dengue and Malaria.

Independence Day: The NSS Unit celebrated 70th Independence Day. Our 83 volunteers came for the flag hoisting. After the flag hoisting and Aazadi Program our NSS Unit organized a flag collection rally in which our 98 volunteers participated. Our volunteers did a very good job by spreading awareness and with the collection of flags.

Blood Donation Camp: The 2nd Blood Donation Camp was organised on 4th February 2017 wherein 101 volunteers donated their blood.

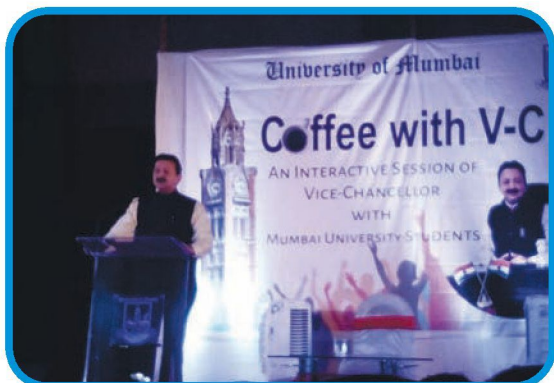
Voter Awareness Rally: 15 Volunteers participated in the Rally for Voter Awareness organised by Mittal College on 15th February 2017.
