1. **Pre-training for 15th August**: On 13th August 2021, there was a discussion of various events and distribution of work amongst the professor and the students was done. Departments allotted were as follows: Attendance - Jitendra sir, Report - Namrata miss, Enrolment - Varsha miss. In all there were 22 volunteers who participated, 7 male and 15 female.

2. Independence Day Celebration: On 15th August 2021, NSS Unit B26 Second year volunteers were present in the college campus at the frontier area during flag hosting and felicitation of dignitaries.
