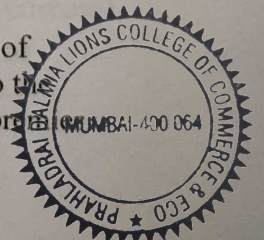
Praja Foundation



Praja Foundation is a non-partisan voluntary organisation which empowers the citizen to participate in governance by providing knowledge and enlisting people's participation. Praja aims to provide ways, in which the citizen can get politically active and involved beyond the ballot box, thus promoting transparency and accountability. Praja Foundation works towards four core sectors in Mumbai's development and issues faced by Aam Mumbaikar namely: Education, Health, Civic and Crime, and publishes regular reports on the same. This mainly involves working with the elected representatives and the administration.

PRAHLADRAI DALMIA LIONS COLLEGE

The Lions Club of Malad-Borivali, an international social organisation realized the necessity of establishing a Commerce College in the western suburb of Mumbai-Malad in 1972 to cater to the needs of the society. The Institution that started with 450 students has today become one of the pri



institutes in the western suburbs. The College endeavours for academic excellence and promotion of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities that promote resilience, creativity and leadership qualities among the students. The College lays great emphasis on inculcating in its students the importance of ethics, hard work and commitment to excellence. The College endeavours to groom its students as icons of tomorrow, potentially contributing to Commerce trade, industry and management. The College inculcates character building qualities like discipline and punctuality in the students. It provides a platform for students to organize various sports and cultural events to participate in various intercollegiate events and to achieve excellence in extra-curricular activities.

A) Project on MCGM Complaint Management

Summary of the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) Complaint Management System:

Complaints regarding civic issues were originally sent to different concerned departments of the Corporation creating confusion and loss of many complaints. Since 2000, MCGM has launched a centralized complaint system wherein complaints from any source such as letters, phone calls, public meetings etc. – are collated in one system, making it easier to respond, maintain, and evaluate the status of the complaints. The complaints will now be automatically lodged in the CCRS (Central Complaint Registration System) that has been integrated in the SAP (System Application Protocol) of MCGM. The system was developed with the help of the logical corollary of the Citizens' Charter. It also has a helpline number – 1916 with multiple hunting lines and amalgamation of multiple services. Complaints are captured at a centralized location with the help of a software application, increasing accountability of the MCGM officers. All the civic complaints are in a single system that can track its status in a real time basis.

Overall Objective of the Praja – Prahladrai Dalmia Lions college:

- To build the student's capacity to understand exactly how the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) Citizen Complaint Redressal Mechanism functions from a practical point of view.
- **Specific Objectives:**
 - To build capacity of the students so that they understand the complaint redressal mechanism of MCGM and identify loopholes in the system.
 - To study the citizen awareness level of the centralized complaint redressal mechanism of MCGM (1916).



- To create awareness among the citizens about the centralized complaint redressal mechanism of MCGM (1916).
 - To understand the workings of the MCGM and how the system functions.
- **Program duration:** 2 months
 - **Guidance and Reporting Authority:** One coordinator from Dalmia College and One from Praja Foundation. Praja will act as a facilitator in the process.

Program Details

- **Group Formation:**

- The 200 students will be divided into 20 groups, ten in each group
- The group will have one group coordinator who will be responsible for regular coordination and reporting. The group leader will regularly e-mail the reports and updates to Praja as well as the college faculty with a copy to all the members of the group. A google group will be created for sharing of each reports and progress.
- The students involved in the project will first and second year Commerce student from Prahladrai Dalmia Lions College.
- All the decisions regarding group will be made by consensus among the group members, providing that decisions are in sync with the objectives of the program.
- The final decision making authority will be Praja and the faculty from college.

- **Activity Plan:**

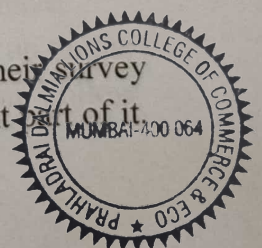
Phase I: **Orientation** – Praja will be conducting orientation session for the students. Session will be conducted separately for first & second year students respectively. In these sessions students will be guided on Objectives of the project, Phase wise plan, Group allocations, Area distribution and outcome of the project. Students will be divided into 20 group, 10 in each group with one coordinator.

- The groups will be assigned a specific locality each according to a ward.
- The students will be randomly assigned ward areas **such** as A ward, B ward, C ward, D ward and E ward for the project.
- Each group will be given one ward locations based on the socio-economic distribution (covering all the socio-economic backgrounds e.g. slums, buildings, etc.).

Students will be oriented on making of survey forms. Students will be making their own survey forms for the project since this project is research based, survey plays an important role. Through this exercise they will learn how to conduct surveys.



Phase II: Preparation of Survey - All 20 groups will be asked to prepare survey form for the project. 20 forms from all twenty groups will be collected within a week after orientation and it will be compiled, finalized by Praja. Students will use the finalized version of the form for the survey.

Phase III:

A. Survey of awareness level of Complaint management system of MCGM of citizen:

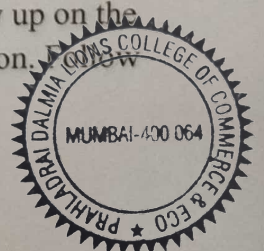
- The group will go to their respective ward to interact with the citizen, and get the survey forms filled by the citizen on the awareness level, and make them aware about 1916.
- Each group will have to administer 20 questionnaires for the project.
- This 20 form should have representation of Buildings, Slums as well as commercial entities.

B. Awareness building among citizen of 1916/ Complaint Registration System:

- The group will also be responsible for spreading awareness on 1916/ complaint management system. For which they have to talk to citizen from different strata of society and explain them about their duty of raising issue by complaints to the administration. This step is done with the above two steps only, when the group is on field.
- The group should fill a form (which Praja will provide) with the citizen name whom the group has interacted on the field, for spreading the awareness regarding the complaint redress mechanism of the MCGM or 1916 specifically.
- Each group needs to interact with 40 and more different people to spread awareness on 1916/Centralized Complaint Management System.

C. Complaint registration by calling 1916:

- The groups are expected to visit the ward assigned to them and look for issue on which complaint could be filed, such as garbage lying by the road side, footpath broken, cover to manhole is missing and so on. They should take pictures of the civic issue that they observe in the locality and register complaints by calling 1916. (Minimum 10 complaints per group).
- When a complaint is made a complaint number is generated, the number has to be noted in the report as it will help in further tracking.
- Leading to this activity of the group will be to track the complaints which they have registered, with the use of the complaint number properly and regularly, follow up on the complaints and also to be able to understand the complete picture of the situation. Follow up can be done by calling 1916 again or going to the MCGM website.



- Once the complaint will be solved/closed by MCGM the group has to go again to the complaint spot to click work done picture, so that report will have Before and after picture, as a success stories.
- These all activities will be recorded in an excel of which the format will be shared by Praja.

D. Analysis of Data Collected through Survey: Students will be analyzing the data collected through Survey. This analysis of data will be made in excel format. excel sheet will be shared by Praja Foundation. Students will be guided by Faculty of Research from the college or Praja Foundation.

E. Evaluation of students: After the completion of project, students will prepare Project Report which will include the procedure of the project from the beginning, their learnings & experience, photos of the complaints registered by them (before & after). Students will have present their Project Report in Microsoft presentation format. The students will be evaluated as groups, on the basis of the number of complaints each group was able to solve as well as the quality of survey, awareness spread and the efforts taken by the students for the same.

Reporting Format: Reporting of the project will happen in two parts (The report can incorporate photographs and also video clips.)

Part 1:

- Introduction of 1916 and the groups understanding of 1916.
- Area Surveyed and localities covered under the assigned ward.
- Experiences and observations of the group, of the project with success stories and limitation of the project
- Survey Findings in the questionnaire into an excel sheet which will be facilitated by Praja Foundation.
- Data of the citizen's awareness form into an Excel file which will be facilitated (Details of the number of people approached for awareness).
- Analysis of the Data.

Part 2:

- Nature of complaints registered.
- Comment on the status of the complaint as to if the complaint has been resolved or is pending.



- **Expectations from students:**

- Before starting the activity, the group is expected to present their draft strategy plan.
- The group leader will keep updating Praja about the progress of the group. He/she will send weekly reports to Praja as well as to college faculty.
- Each group is expected to write a report of their understanding, learning, observations and experiences from the activity. It should also include their suggestions and/or recommendations.
- The group must be at their best behavior while conducting the survey and associating with the administration.
- Final presentations will be made to Praja and the college faculty after the completion of the above tasks.

- **Deliverables:**

- Praja Foundation:**

- The foundation will be responsible for orienting the given students of first & second year students of Commerce on the project.
- Research methodology will be given by Praja, with questionnaire
- Format for the reporting will be provided by Praja
- Any assistance needed when on filed a help on phone will be provided by Praja
- A certificate on the accomplishment of the program with satisfactory performance will be provided.

Note: No monetary incentives will be given for the said program by parties involved. Students will need to bear the expenses to be incurred on travel and food.

Prahladrai Dalmia College:

Program Logistics:

The students are expected to work every day barring one day of the week wherein they will have to report at their college. The students will be divided into groups and assigned specific wards. one coordinator will be selected from each group, who will report to Praja as well as the college faculty regularly.

B. Praja Conducts sessions of different issues of governance

Skill development/ awareness building workshops:

- Few workshops will be held on different issues on governance such as urban governance, R.T.I Act, Departments of M.C.G.M with students of various sections at Dalmia College.
- Praja Officials would conduct interactive sessions on class room level.
- Few workshop will be arranged on the issue which other NGOs will conduct facilitated by Praja. For example, Visual Police stations, SWM, Constitution of India, and women safety as so on.



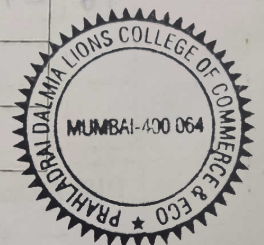
