The Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) Unit of *Prahladrai Dalmia Lions College of Commerce and Economics* organized a **Blood Donation and Blood Group Detection Drive** on **25th August 2025**. The drive was conducted in collaboration with the **Lions Club of Malad-Borivli** and the **Sir J.J. Hospital Blood Bank**.

A total of 144 enthusiastic participants registered for blood donation, reflecting their strong sense of social responsibility. After medical and hemoglobin checks, 70 healthy donors were able to successfully donate blood This not only highlights their noble contribution but also shows the overwhelming spirit and willingness of our students to come forward for such a cause. The remaining registered students too deserve appreciation for their intent and effort, as their readiness itself is a sign of their compassion and commitment towards society.

A total of 193 students (Degree+Junior) took advantage of the Blood Group Detection Camp

The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from students, faculty, and staff members. The purpose of the drive was to create awareness about the importance of voluntary blood donation, encourage students to contribute towards saving lives, and to help individuals know their blood group for future health and medical requirements.

## • Blood Donation Drive:

A total of **144 registrations** were received for blood donation. After medical examination and screening, **70 donors were qualified** and successfully donated blood. This significant contribution will benefit patients in need and support the blood bank in ensuring an adequate blood supply.

## • Blood Group Detection Drive:

Alongside the donation drive, a **Blood Group Detection Camp** was also organized. A total of **193 students registered** and successfully received their blood group test results. This initiative was especially helpful for students who were unaware of their blood group, enabling them to be better prepared for medical emergencies.

The event was well coordinated by the DLLE team, under the guidance of the college authorities, in association with expert doctors and technicians from Sir J.J. Hospital Blood Bank. Volunteers from DLLE actively assisted in registrations, donor care, and smooth conduct of the drive.

The program concluded successfully with appreciation from both participants and organizers. The collective efforts reflected the spirit of social responsibility and community service, making the event a memorable and impactful initiative.
