All events were conducted for **boys and girls** of both Degree and Junior College categories, ensuring inclusive participation and healthy competition throughout the day.

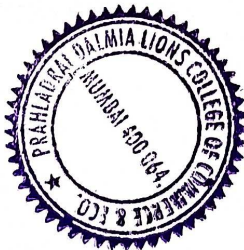
Conclusion
