Report on DLLE . BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

- **Event Description-**

On September 24th, 2024, Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension of Prahladrai Dalmia Lions College of Commerce and Economics In association with Lions Club of Malad Borivali and Blood Bank Sir J.J.Hospital Mumbai, organized a blood donation camp. This event encouraged students and staff to donate blood and help save the lives of people in need. The primary objective of the blood donation camp was to address the ongoing blood shortage in local hospitals and medical facilities. By encouraging community members to donate blood, the aim was to replenish blood supplies and potentially save lives.

Donors were greeted by volunteers and directed to the registration area, where they provided their personal information and underwent a brief medical screening to ensure eligibility for donation. Eligible donors proceeded to the donation area, where trained medical staff collected blood samples using sterile equipment. Donors reclined comfortably during the donation process, which typically lasted around 10–15 minutes per donor.

After the donation, to help replenish their energy donors were provided with refreshments and snacks by the Management of the College. Medical staff monitored donors for any adverse reactions following donation and provided necessary care if needed.

Throughout the event, volunteers and organizers conducted an awareness campaign to educate attendees about the importance of regular blood donation and its life-saving impact on patients in need.

A total of 150 individuals were registered for actual donation, due to lack of Hemoglobin and other issues they were debarred from donating a blood and actual 84 bottles of blood were collected.

The blood donation camp was a resounding success, thanks to the overwhelming support and generosity of the Management, Principal, Students and Staff of the College. By coming together to donate blood, individuals demonstrated their commitment to helping others in need and making a positive difference in the community's health and well-being. The organizers extend their heartfelt gratitude to all donors, volunteers, and partners who contributed to the success of the event.
