To further the spirit of enquiry, every year the Student Research Cell conducts intercollegiate conferences on issues related to the youth. The Department of Business Communication and IQAC has been organizing Student Research Conferences since 2015-16 centered on the theme of the year.

The theme of the year was Relational Value; based on this theme an inter-collegiate conference on 'Youth & Relational Values' was organized on 23rd February, 2019 by the Department of Business Communication and Student Research Cell under the aegis of IQAC, in the college auditorium. It was a conference organized 'by the students for the students'.
