The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) was passed in 2005 with an aim to enhance the livelihood security of people in rural areas. It guaranteed 100 days of wage employment to unskilled manual workers.

A unique survey of over 20,000 rural household came up with some interesting results comparing the facts in 2004-05 to those in 2011-12. The participations of men and women in 2004-05 was 12.2% and 8.8% respectively which rose up to 23.4% and 17.7% respectively which can be regarded as a considerable growth.

The percentage of MGNREGA participants taking loans from private money - lenders sharply from 47.9% in 2004-05 to 26.7 % in 2011-12. The scheme acted considerably in reducing the reliance of people of private money-lenders.

Nearly 34.2% participants borrowed from formal sources such as banks and self- help groups as compared to 23.9% in 2004-05. MGNREGA's focus on direct payment to participants through banks may account for this improvement.

The average annual interest paid by the participants fell sharply from 38.5 % in 2004-05 to 29.6% in 2011-12. This is indicative of their shifts from paying higher interests to money-lenders.

The poverty ratio in 2004-05 was 52.2%. By 2011-12, it dropped to 31.9%. This clearly proves the fact that MGNREGA fared well in the first decade.

Newspapers, especially of the popular variety, aim to do two things: to inform and to entertain.

Entertainment may be principally found in the centre pages of newspaper, in some of the feature articles and some local news stories. The principal aim of the short news report on the front pages is to inform.

Most newspapers are published daily and the news reporters must make sure that they have up to the minute news. In their news report they will aim to create a sense of immediacy, to convey the impression that they have rushed the news to the reader and 'that the information contained in the very latest.'

Reporters also wish to create a sense of authenticity, that is, that their news is accurate and genuine.

The editor of the paper also benefits from this format, for if he or she runs out of space in the paper, some of the last paragraphs of the story can be deleted without too much harm.


