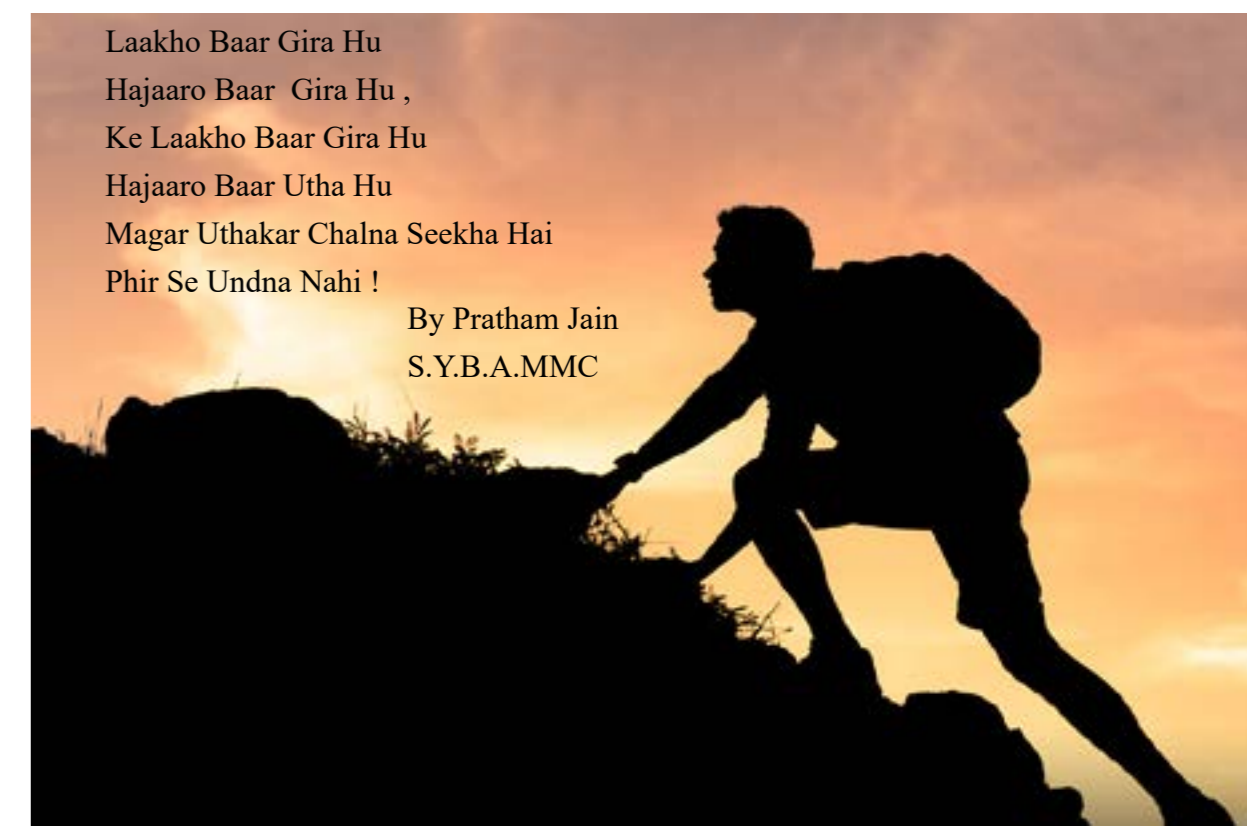


My summer Internship experience

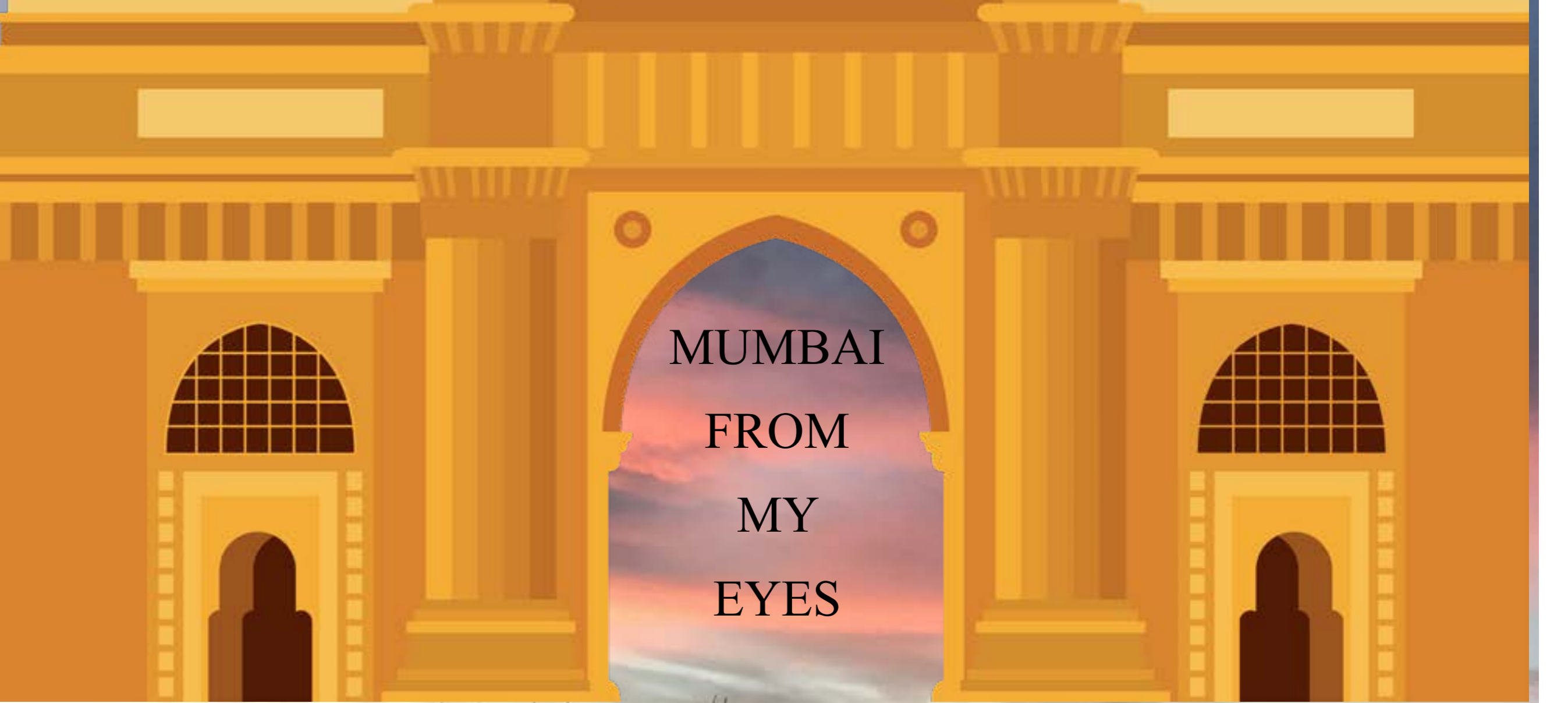

The eldest daughter of Deenanath Mangeshkar born in Indore her birth name was Hema which later changed to Lata which was based on a character of Deenanath's play. Lata Mangeshkar faced many challenges in her family as well as her musical journey her father died when Lata was very young she overtook all the responsibility of her family and she flawlessly manage to do so, her first singing lessons were thought to her by

her father, at the beginning of her musical journey many music composer rejected her singing her voice is too flat some even criticized her vocabulary of Hindi and Urdu language, she worked on her language and pitch and got her first big break with the song 'Dil Mera Toda, Mujhe Kahin Ka Na Chhora' in the movie majboor by music director Ghulam Haider, after that there was no looking back. If we talk about her musical career in numbers she sang almost Thirty Thousand songs which is Guinness world record for the most number of song recorded in studio she lend her voice in 2000 films and in 36 languages, she sang most of her duets with



Mohammed Rafi, The shining star of the movie worked with all most all the music composer except O.P Nayyar who said Lata's voice is "Thin and Shril" for his compositions. Lata's voice struck the strings of love in everybody's heart but what about her love life although she likes to keep her personal life private but she did had an alleged affair with Raj Singh ji son of ruler of Dungarpur Rajasthan this relationship ended because the family of Raj Singh Ji was critical about it, nevertheless she did not forgot to believe in true love and that was clear with the meledy of her songs. Lata Mangeshkar was not only a singer but also an actor and

music composer as well in the seven decades of her melodious journey she went on to receive various awards including Bharat Ratana the highest civilian award, she saw the British India, The Independent India and she saw billion of people falling in love with her. She was bid adieu on 6th February with the state organized ceremony, the National Flag at the top of Sansad and Rashtrapati Bhavan were lowered to mourn the legend and the state of Maharashtra Declared public holiday on 7th February, A well suited Farewell to the legend.

The morning of Feb 16, 2022, can be summed up with emotions unprecedented and a Dawn of Disbelief for fans of Alokesh Lahiri famously known as Bappi Lahiri. He is also called the pioneer

of Juke joint and Jazz music .The man we know was the one who brought trend of Disco songs in India, He was a singer, composer, famously known for his albums like Disco dancer, Chalte Chalte, Geet. He made his presence in the business in 70s and was considered to be the needle mover of Bengali films on the box office in 80s and 90s. Other than Hindi and

Gujarati he also composed songs in other regional languages like Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Gujarati. At the early career of mere years Lahiri had worked with the big names like Lata Mangeshkar, Mukesh Da and many more. He didn't stopped even in

February of 2022 will go down in history of Indian music as it saw end of eras, On 15th February, 2022, Getashree Sandhya Mukherjee took her last breath. Sandhya Mukherjee was one of the best classical singers ever born and one of the most famous singers in the Bengali film Industry, she was a singer, lyricist and was considered the queen of duets in the Bengali film Industry. Started her career in Bollywood, she began her mainstream musical journey in music in Mumbai with Taraana (1951) under

composer Anil Biswas. She sang a duet 'Bol papiha bol' with Lata Mangeshkar in the film. Mukherjee lent her voice for around 17 Hindi films before going back to her home in Kolkata and settled there. Later on, She made a legacy in Bengali film Industry. Mukherjee worked with names like S.D. Burman, Hemantkumar Mukhopadhyay and many more. Her most significant duets were with Bengali singer Hemanta Kumar, especially when she did the playback for actress Suchitra Sen. In the late 70s

she started writing lyrics for her own songs as well. No duet was ever complete without her voice during the 60s and 70s. She won National Film Award for Best Female Playback Singer for the songs "Amader Chuti Chuti" Jay Jayanti and "Ore Sakol Sona Molin Holo" Nishi Padma in 1971. She was awarded Banga Bibhushan the highest civilian award in West Bengal state in year 2011 and at start of 2022 it was announced that she will be awarded Padma Shri

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
