Activities Conducted :

Twinning Day

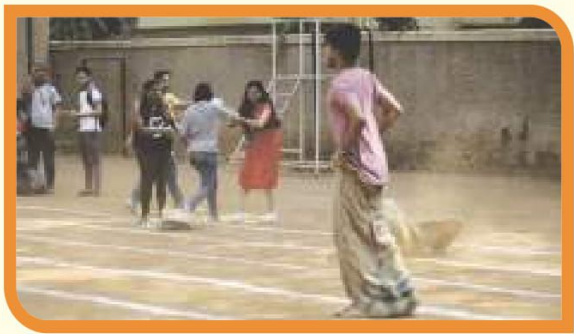
