

BCom (Accounting & Finance) & BCom (Investment & Management)

The course of the BCom (Accounting & Finance) has an emphasis in the areas of Accounts, Cost Accounting, Financial Management, Direct and Indirect Taxes. This course helps the students to have a deep and specialized knowledge specifically in the area of Accounting and Finance through the intensive syllabus and extra-curricular activities that focus on toal personality development.

The course Bcom (Investment Management) was started from this academic year 2016-17. The motive being giving our students interested in the field of Investment Management a practical exposure to the field and in depth understanding of the field through experts from the Industry.

Activities:

- Lectures for First year students (BAF & BIM) commenced from 11th July, 2016 followed by Orientation. The PPT briefed them about the college, the general discipline of the college, extracurricular activities, and future prospects after completing BAF.
- Prof. Shilpa Dhanuka started with the class Activity of "Best Practice" of news paper reading with the learners of SYBAF.
- Learners of SYBAF were taken for the BSE Visit on 28th July, 2016 for exploring
 the practical aspects of the accounting world. The visit was taken Prof. Shilpa
