### Report of Educational Field visit to Dahanu road related to Alternative Lifestyle Farming Project

On 30th JULY, 2025

An Alternative Lifestyle-Farming Project was conducted with the aim of introducing students to sustainable and eco-friendly farming practices. The session was guided by Mr. Kundan Raut, an Environmentalist and Expert in Alternative Lifestyle management and taken help by two teaching staff members of Commerce Department, Ms. Anita Panigrahi and Dr. Sachin Bansode, along with one non-teaching staff member, Mr. Sandip Tiwari. A total of 28 students participated in the project, comprising 15 girls and 13 boys. The program began with an informative session on alternative farming techniques such as organic farming, composting, and terrace gardening. This was followed by a practical field demonstration where students got hands-on experience in compost preparation, seed sowing, and water conservation methods. An interactive session was held, allowing students to share their thoughts on sustainable living and understand the long-term benefits of chemical-free agriculture. The session concluded with a Q&A round, where students enthusiastically interacted with the staff and clarified their doubts.
